

2024 Rider Info Sheet

- ✓ Visit <u>www.vcgp.com</u> or Social Media pages for copies of **Town & Race Event Maps** to assist with navigation and race processes.
- ✓ Allow time to Register/Check-in. **ALL racers MUST check-in** to activate their scoring transponder, sign their waiver and pickup their racer packet (pit passes and bike # stickers). MotoTally Transponders are mounted on helmets at time of check-in. **Bring your helmet!!**
- ✓ Pay attention to your start row and plan to get your bike loaded on Main "C" Street with
 ample time to start your race at 10am each day. Bikes must load as directed in the Race Map.
- ✓ All bikes must have their **Tech Inspection** sticker to start the race. **Spark arresters are required.** Get checked-in then bring your bike and helmet to Tech. *See Race Map for location.*
- Racers must race the entire 4 or 3-hour race ("take checkers") to receive **finisher pin**.

 Experienced racers bring a watch or timer to know where they're at in their race time elapsed prior to returning to the scoring lane. It takes ~20 min to get bikes off the start line each day.
- ✓ Each racer is given **TWO** pit-passes for their support crews. Pit-pass required for Pit entry. Pit crew must sign liability waiver. Pit-passes are not available for sale. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Racers are responsible for their Pit crews. Violation of posted pit rules will result in an immediate disqualification and end of their rider's race day.

Most importantly, have **FUN**, stay **SAFE**, and **be RESPECTFUL** to our town and each other to ensure this race continues for years to come!



Camping

-Opens at Fairgrounds on 4/24 - First come, first serve -Street camping is prohibited - use provided camp area -Be courteous to your neighbors and our town -WHITE fuel fires only per Fire Department mandate

Rider Check-In/Registration & Merch/Vendor Mall

- -Required for ALL racers (Pre & Post Entries)
- -MUST BRING HELMET to mount/register transponder
- -Existing rider MotoTally transponders accepted (transponders provided with entry)

-All racers & pit support must sign a liability waivers

Pits

-Pits will open on Friday at 8am for equipment drop-offs
-Wrist Band required to enter pits (2 given per rider)
-Absolutely NO SMOKING, alcohol, children or pets
-Pit stalls/space VERY limited. Share and consolidate.
-Items are left unattended at your own discretion

Tech Inspection

-Tech Inspection Required - must have sticker to race -Spark arrestor required per BLM requirements -Racer check-in then Tech (Helmet & Bike #'s req'd)

Trophies

-Trophies presented onsite in front of Freight Depot -Trophies available for P/U onsite, then Michael's Reno

Pit-Bike Barrel Racing

- -Will start at the Fairgrounds at 1pm and end at 6pm.
- -\$20 entry and each racer will get two runs on the barrels (Match Scoring).
- -Motorcycles will be provided. Bring your own helmet, goggles, gloves, etc.

Camping

NO STREET CAMPING!! This will be enforced every year. Please utilize the fairgrounds camping area or one of the established RV areas like the RV Park. Do not camp without permission in non-designated camp area(s).

Town Tips

-Virginia City is an alpine town (6100' with very little oxygen). It's very STEEP in all directions. Plan accordingly. Geiger Grade & Six Mile Canyon are very steep roadways into VC. The Truck Route from Moundhouse is your easiest trek if you are hauling a trailer.

-Riding offroad vehicles (dirtbikes/SXS's) on paved roadways are done so at your own risk. As a general rule, the town is aware of what our event brings so be courteous and minimize your time on pavement. Except for the race start, DO NOT RIDE offroad vehicles down the Main "C" Street. It is a state route and you're subject to being ticketed. **ALWAYS wear helmets when riding!**
